Assistant/Associate Professor in Architecture

This is a search for a tenure-track full-time faculty member whose appointment will begin August 2009. The position is available for candidates qualified to offer instruction in **architectural design** and other courses in areas of the candidate's expertise. In particular, expertise in one of these areas is desired: building technology, sustainability, building performance, digital media, or fabrication. We invite ambitious and creative new faculty to join our efforts.

The architecture program at the University of Kansas is comprised of a broad range of faculty interests that encourage experimentation in design, representation, fabrication, and theory. The school has expanded its resources and offerings in recent years to include expanded workshop spaces, a digital fabrication laboratory, internationally-recognized design/build programs, a study abroad requirement for all students, service-learning opportunities in local communities, and a Kansas City Urban Design studio. We believe in providing students with diverse experiences and a comprehensive design education that will prepare them for a rapidly changing profession and culture.

Required qualifications: 1) Master of Architecture (M.Arch.) degree or equivalent; 2) professional, architectural experience; 3) demonstrated ability to engage in architectural design instruction; and 4) demonstrated record of recognized creative work which may include built work, theoretical explorations, scholarship, publications, exhibitions, or competitions.

Preferred Qualifications: 1) professional registration is highly preferred; and 2) demonstrated expertise in building technology, sustainability, building performance, digital media, or fabrication.

Applications and nominations will be accepted until the position is filled. Applications should be received by January 20, 2009. Applicants should submit: 1) a letter of intent including a statement outlining their area of expertise, research interests and scholarly development and how they see that area contributing to the professional-degree program at the University of Kansas; 2) a hard-copy selection of professional, research and student work (as applicable); 3) curriculum vitae; and 4) the names and contact information of three references to:
